Subject: **SHOW CAUSE NOTICE UNDER SECTION 7(b) READ WITH SECTION 5(1)(a) OF THE PEEDA ACT, 2006**

WHEREAS, it has been reported that you, Ms. Aisha Tariq, Ex-Psychologist (BS-18/Personal), were granted Ex-Pakistan Extraordinary Leave (without pay) w.e.f. 04.09.2022 to 06.09.2025 (1094 days) vide order dated 09.09.2022. That subsequently, you applied for extension of Ex-Pakistan Extraordinary Leave w.e.f. 07.09.2025 to 06.09.2027 (730 days), which was duly considered and rejected by the Secretary Special Education/ Competent Authority vide letter dated 23.10.2025, with clear directions to report back for duty immediately. Despite the said explicit directions of the Competent Authority, you have willfully failed, neglected, and refused to resume your duties and have remained absent from duty without any lawful justification and without approval of leave from the competent authority. Your said act constitutes misconduct, inefficiency, and violation of lawful orders of the competent authority, thereby attracting disciplinary action under the provisions of the Punjab Employees Efficiency, Discipline and Accountability (PEEDA) Act, 2006.

2. AND WHEREAS, the undersigned being Competent Authority, under the Punjab Employees Efficiency, Discipline and Accountability Act, 2006, in due consideration of the facts of the case, is of the view that you **Ms. Aisha Tariq**, Ex-Psychologist (BS-18/Personal), Govt. Secondary Special Education Centre, Liaquatpur, District Rahim Yar Khan, have been found guilty of misconduct on account of following charge:

"You have been found willfully absent from your duty w.e.f. 07.09.2025 to till date without prior permission / approval of leave by the Competent Authority."

3. AND WHEREAS, the undersigned is of the opinion that in view of availability of sufficient documentary evidence on record it is not necessary to hold an inquiry into the matter in view of the provision contained in Section 5 (1)(b) of the Act *ibid*. It is, therefore, decided to proceed against you under Section 7(b) read with Section 5 (1)(a) of Punjab Employees Efficiency, Discipline and Accountability Act, 2006.

4. NOW, THEREFORE, you are hereby called upon to show cause in writing **within 07-days** of the receipt of this notice as to why one or more of the penalties as prescribed under Section 4 of the Punjab Employees Efficiency,

Discipline and Accountability Act, 2006 should not be imposed upon you.

5. Your reply to Show Cause Notice should reach the undersigned, within the said period failing which it shall be presumed that you have no defence to offer and you have admitted the charge.

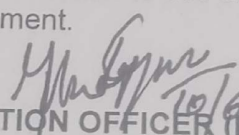
