

**ORDER OF INQUIRY**

No. SO(ESTT.)2-47/2008: **WHEREAS**, it has come to the notice of the Competent Authority that fake, fictitious and forged transfer/posting orders dated 11.05.2025, purportedly issued by the Special Education Department, Government of the Punjab, were circulated through social media platforms, including WhatsApp groups causing serious administrative confusion, misrepresentation of official record, and damage to the reputation and integrity of the Department. Accordingly, this Department, vide letter No. SO(ESTT-I)34-67/2012(2662) dated 14.05.2026, informed all concerned authorities that the aforesaid transfer/posting orders had neither been issued nor authenticated by the Competent Authority and were, therefore, fake, fictitious and forged documents. Preliminary scrutiny conducted by the Department further revealed that the forged orders were deliberately fabricated and circulated to mislead the officers concerned, field formations, and the general public, constituting a violation of government service discipline and official propriety. It has further been revealed that **Mr. Muhammad Amir Raza S/o Muhammad Bilal Hameed**, Instructor Physical Education (BS-18/Personal), Govt. Special Education Centre Jahanian District Khanewal ("**Accused Officer No.1**"), and **Ms. Fouzia Faheem Khan**, SSET (BS-18 Personal/PD), Govt. Special Education Centre Muridkey Sheikhpura ("**Accused Officer No.2**"), are involved in the preparation, fabrication and/or facilitation of the aforesaid forged transfer/posting orders. The acts and omissions attributable to the aforementioned accused officers are of a serious nature involving alleged forgery, fraud, misrepresentation, unauthorized use of official documents, tampering with administrative processes, abuse of authority, and attempts to obtain unlawful benefit through illegal means.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, undersigned being Competent Authority, under the Punjab Employees Efficiency, Discipline and Accountability Act, 2006 ('Act'), in due consideration of the facts of the case, is of considered opinion that there are sufficient grounds to proceed against **Mr. Muhammad Amir Raza S/o Muhammad Bilal Hameed**, Instructor Physical Education (BS-18/Personal), Govt. Special Education Centre Jahanian District Khanewal ("**Accused Officer No.1**"), and **Ms. Fouzia Faheem Khan**, SSET (BS-18 Personal/PD), Govt. Special Education Centre Muridkey Sheikhpura ("**Accused Officer No.2**"), on the charges of inefficiency and misconduct, under section 5 read with Section 9 of the Act *ibid*. I, therefore, order initiation of joint disciplinary proceedings through a regular inquiry against the accused officers under the Act *ibid* by constituting following Inquiry Committee to proceed against the accused officers in terms of Section 5 read with Section 9 of the Act *ibid*;

3. The Inquiry Committee will jointly proceed against the accused officers and official on the following charges of inefficiency and misconduct:

- i. That the accused officers namely Mr. Amir Raza and Ms. Fouzia Faheem Khan, are involved in preparation, fabrication and/or facilitation of the said fake transfer/posting order. The said act were done to obtain a posting of their choice, to which they were not entitled to under the applicable transfer policy of Special Education Department, seniority criteria, thereby attempting to obtain an undue benefit, favour, and fraudulent relief to the detriment of the public service and the merit-based transfer policy of the Department.
- ii. That the accused officers, in continuation of and in furtherance of the acts described in Charge No. 1, did knowingly facilitated the dissemination of the said fake, forged, and fictitious transfer/posting order through Social Media platforms and/or WhatsApp Groups, with the deliberate motive of creating confusion among the field formations, deceiving the Heads of Institutions, District Education Officers, and other stakeholders, and fraudulently projecting the said forged order as a genuine official document of the Government.
- iii. That the accused officers individually or in conspiracy with any other person(s), prepared, procured, caused to be prepared, or otherwise facilitated the fabrication of fake transfer/posting orders purportedly issued by the Special Education Department and attempted to obtain undue benefit, or irregular relief by misuse of the said forged instruments.
4. The accused officers are directed to submit their written defence to the Inquiry Committee, within **07** days of the receipt of this order. If they fail to submit their written defence within the prescribed period, it shall be presumed that either they have no defence to offer or they have declined to offer the same and they have accepted the charges.
5. **Mr. Muhammad Ilyas**, Superintendent (BS-17), Office of Directorate General of Special Education, Punjab, Lahore is appointed as Departmental Representative in terms of Section 9(1)(c) read with Section 12 of the Act *ibid*.
6. In case, the accused officers desires to consult any record on which the aforesaid charges are based or is relevant to the aforesaid charges, they may do so with prior arrangement with the Departmental Representative within **03** days of the receipt of this Order.
7. The Inquiry Committee will submit report and recommendations to the undersigned within sixty days (**60 days**) of the initiation of inquiry in terms of Section 10(6) of the Act *ibid*.
