**ORDER**

No. LO(Writ)1-49/2020. WHEREAS, through this order, applications filed by Ms. Majida Butt daughter of Khadam Hussain Butt Resident of House No.593, Block No.2, Sector D-1, Township, Lahore, a retired employee of Special Education Department, who during her service was proceeded against departmentally under PEEDA Act, 2006 and awarded major penalty of recovery ("applicant") before President of Pakistan dated 07.11.2025 and Chief Secretary, Punjab dated 07.11.2025 are sought to be decided.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the applicant filed same application before President of Pakistan and Chief Secretary, Punjab and both applications have been forwarded to Special Education Departments vide letters dated 17.12.2025 and 13.11.2025 for necessary action as per law and rules. Through her applications, the applicant has requested initiation of proceedings under the PEEDA Act, 2006 on account of alleged financial mismanagement and administrative irregularities relating to the Shadab Village Project, which she describes as a flagship initiative of the then Chief Minister, Punjab. She has requested to conduct a special audit of all expenditures incurred on the land allocated for the Shadab Village Project; initiation of disciplinary action against officers related to the project on account of alleged negligence during site inspections and conduct of a special audit of all ADP schemes of the Directorate General of Special Education from 2018 to date.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, in view of principles of natural justice, to ascertain the veracity of allegations levelled in the applications and to adjudicate the matter on merits, the applicant was afforded opportunities of personal hearing on 10.12.2025 and 24.12.2025; however, despite due intimation of hearing notices on residential address of the applicant, she failed to appear. Nevertheless, the available record related to the case has been thoroughly examined and it has been noted that the applicant, despite not being a party to the proceedings regarding land in question, has approached office of President of Pakistan and office of Chief Secretary, Punjab through above cited applications, seeking relief as mentioned in para-02/ante. The applications filed by the applicant suffers from the following infirmities:

- i. It has been noted that earlier the applicant filed similar application on CM Portal which was examined and dropped / rejected in which following terms:

*"The complaint has been thoroughly examined in light of the available record and it has come to the notice of the Department that an earlier complaint bearing substantially the same allegations,*

content, and prayer was filed by another individual, namely Mr. Shahzeb Tanveer. Said complaint, after due scrutiny and fair assessment on merit, was found to be baseless and devoid of substance, whereupon it was conclusively disposed of with the observation that no further action is warranted."

- ii. The present applications are mirror image of the previously adjudicated matter and appears to be a thinly veiled attempt to reopen a closed chapter.
- iii. The applicant lacks *locus standi* to challenge the orders of the department which have been taken in accordance with the law, as she has not demonstrated any direct legal interest or aggrievement in the matter.
- iv. It has been noted with grave concern that filing of same application before different forums without any *locus standi*, containing identical allegations and seeking same relief, despite earlier closure on merits, is mischievous and also borders on *mala fide* intent. Such conduct is clearly abuse of administrative process, and amounts to squandering precious public resources and time that could otherwise be utilized for the redressal of legitimate public concerns.
- v. The applicant failed to appear on the dates fixed for hearing to substantiate her stance. It has been observed that the applicant has not been able to put forth any stance through her applications to show her nexus with these proceedings.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, it is also pertinent to mention here that record manifestly demonstrate that all official proceedings and decisions undertaken by the Special Education Department with regards to allotment of land and its subsequent return to Colonies Department, Govt. of the Punjab, are conducted in strict compliance with relevant statutory provisions; prescribed rules and regulations; and established procedural frameworks. Special Education Department operates under an unwavering commitment to principles of objectivity, fairness, and transparency in its administrative and quasi-judicial functions. Any suggestion of partiality, bias, or discriminatory conduct is wholly without merit, unsupported by evidence, and contrary to the official record.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, it has been observed that the applications filed by the applicant are based on jumbled and incoherent facts narrated in a confused manner, vague in details, raising diverse and indefinite grounds requiring multidimensional action to be taken for fishing out some kind of a case. All the grounds taken by the applicant in her applications are not sustainable and could not hold field as the same are merely a self-harboured hypothetical assumption on her part, bereft of legal backing. Moreover, the applicant, while referring certain documents in her applications, is only looking at the skin of letters while refusing to consider the soul of the said letters issued in accordance with the law. In nutshell, all the grounds raised by the applicant in the present matter indeed come across as misdirected and misaimed having no relevance. Thus, it is

concluded that all the arguments of the applicant are *prima facie* fallacious and naïve on more grounds than one.

6. **NOW, THEREFORE**, in the light of aforementioned facts and reasons, the applicant has not provided any justification, *either factual or legal*, that warrants indulgence. Moreover, failure of the applicant to appear for hearings further weakens her case and raises questions on the *bona fide* of the applications. Accordingly, the applications of the applicant are hereby **rejected** being untenable and not covered under the law/rules.


