2. The above appointments are subject to the conditions that:
- i. They are citizens of Pakistan and are domiciled in the Punjab.
 - ii. They possess the qualification and experience as prescribed in the relevant service rules of the post.
 - iii. They are not married to foreign nationals.
 - iv. Their services will be governed under the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 and the rules framed there-under and instructions / orders issued by the Punjab Government from time to time.
 - v. The above appointees upon their regular appointment will remain on probation in terms of Section 5 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 and Rule 7 of the Punjab Civil Servants (Appointment and Conditions of Services) Rules, 1974.
 - vi. Their period of service as contract employees will not be counted for any purpose (pension, gratuity, leave, etc). The salary component of such employees will be in accordance with the pay scale plus the usual allowances prescribed for the post against which they are now appointed. They will, however, not be entitled to payment of 30% social security benefit in lieu of pension or any other pay package being drawn by them.
 - vii. The pay of the employees as being appointed on regular basis shall be fixed at the initial of the respective basic pay scale and the increment(s) already earned during the period of contract appointment shall be converted into Personal Allowance.
3. The inter-se-seniority of all above appointees shall be maintained in the individual cadres and order of merit as assigned by the Punjab Public Service Commission.
4. On their appointment on regular basis, they shall continue working at their present places of posting.
