## ORDER

No. 16/1670-Admn:15. WHEREAS, Mr. Abdul Jabbar, Driver, Government Special Education Centre, Hasilpur, District Bahawalpur filed Writ Petition No. 1199/2020 in the Honourable Lahore High Court, Bahawalpur Bench, Bahawalpur against his transfer to Govt. Special Education Centre, Mandi Baha-ud-Din. The instant Writ Petition was disposed of by the Hon'ble Court on 18.02.2020 with the following directions:

*"Petitioner seeks direction for decision on appeal.*

*Learned AAG submits that there is no proof of filing any appeal, attached with this petition.*

*2. Be that as it may, if appeal of the petitioner is pending, the same be decided strictly in accordance with law, keeping in view the limitation, if any, for maintainability of the appeal.*

*3. Disposed off."*

2. **AND WHEREAS**, pursuant to the direction of Honourable Lahore High Court, Bahawalpur Bench, Bahawalpur, the Petitioner was afforded an opportunity of personal hearing on 16.03.2020. During hearing, the Petitioner stated that he had been working as Driver at Govt. Special Education Centre, Hasilpur, District Bahawalpur and there was no complaint against him from any corner regarding his work and conduct. He further stated that his children are studying in Hasilpur. He contended that he was transferred to Govt. Special Education Centre, M.B.Din vide order dated 12.02.2020 on administrative grounds and prayed for acceptance of her representation/appeal and setting aside the order dated 12.02.2020 issued by Deputy Director (Admn.), Directorate General of Special Education, Punjab.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the Petitioner was appointed as Driver (BS-05) and posted at Govt. Special Education Centre, Hasilpur, District Bahawalpur vide order dated 31.10.2009. He was transferred to Govt. Special Education Centre, M.B.Din vide order dated 12.02.2020. The transfer orders dated 12.02.2020 was further modified and he was posted at Govt. Special Education Centre, Chistian, District Bahawalnagar. The total tenure of the Petitioner in Bahawalpur was more than 10 years and Transfer Policy of the Govt. of the Punjab does not restrict the Competent Authority to make transfer after completion of three years tenure at a particular place

of posting. Therefore, in order to ensure better delivery of service, Deputy Director (Admn.)/ Competent Authority transferred the Petitioner to Govt. Special Education Centre, M.B.Din on administrative grounds. Furthermore, under Section 9 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974, a civil servant is liable to serve anywhere in the Province.

4. **NOW, THEREFORE**, in the light of above stated facts, I, Syed Javed Iqbal Bokhari, Secretary Special Education / Respondent No.1, hereby reject the representation of the Petitioner / Mr. Abdul Jabbar, Driver, Government Special Education Centre, Hasilpur, District Bahawalpur. The order dated 18.02.2020 passed by the Honourable Lahore High Court, Bahawalpur Bench, Bahawalpur in the Writ Petition No. 1199/2020 is accordingly complied with in the above stated manner.
